St Luke's is Sheffield's Hospice, with a vision to support and care for everyone affected by terminal illness in Sheffield. We are a community organisation which means that everything we do is focused on helping people in their own communities as well as at our Little Common Lane site and our new, adjoining site on Ecclesall Road South. Our shops are all based in the heart of communities across the city, as are our amazing volunteers and we couldn't do what we do without them.

The Retail Department provides a third of St Luke's funds to support the people of Sheffield. We have 13 outlets on the high street across Sheffield and our Donation Centre where our e-trading site is also based.

What does this role involve?

To provide support to the shop manager and deputy manager. Your role will be to keep the shop floor and back of house area clean and tidy and to provide a welcoming and inclusive space for customers, volunteers, and staff. This will include our communal areas and toilet areas as well as external areas of the shop.

Tasks

We do require you to assist in:

- Cleaning allocated parts of the shop floor, customer changing rooms and back of house areas as part of an ongoing cleaning rota.
- Vacuuming carpeted areas and mopping floors to ensure no slip / trip hazards.
- Sweeping uncarpeted areas
- Emptying and cleaning bins and ensuring recyclable items are in the correct bin
- Cleaning toilet areas and replenishing toiletries
- Cleaning doors and windows
- Checking stock levels of cleaning materials
- Reporting all defects/hazards immediately to the shop manager / deputy shop manager

Walkways & Shared Spaces

- Ensure all walkways & Fire Exits are kept clear at all times
- Ensure shared spaces are kept tidy and free of clutter

Outside Spaces

• Car Park / Shop front pavement (if applicable) - keep litter free & clean.

- Be flexible, willing to learn and follow guidance/processes
